Please read this letter thoroughly. It includes detailed information which is essential to the smooth functioning of the workshop.

You are not required to bring your own animal companion to the course. Other students may bring animals to campus who are used to and enjoy participating in this kind of setting. These animals may include dogs, cats, llamas, birds, rabbits, and snakes. We recommend that you bring photos of your animal friends who are at home. During the course, we will also be communicating with animals at a distance.

If you have an animal companion who travels well, we would be delighted to have you bring him or her to the workshop. However, please make sure you adhere to the following guidelines:

- a. **Animals are NOT ALLOWED to stay in housing on Omega Institute's campus.** Please refer to the enclosed local accommodations that allow pets. They may be brought to campus **only during designated workshop sessions.**
- b. Please make sure your pet is in a carrier or on a leash while on campus during designated workshop sessions.
- c. You will be responsible for the care and well-being of your pet companion at ALL times, both when workshop is in session, and during breaks.
- d. Please make sure you bring adequate food and water for your pet.
- e. **You MUST bring** your vet papers with you. Your pet must be in good health, and have been properly vaccinated within the year. These vaccinations should include rabies. If you have any questions regarding health or veterinary guidelines, call Omega.
